LOCATION + PARKING

The Start is near the Agua Centrum on Ulica Hallera. Free parking is available at the nearby supermarkets and Aqua Centrum itself. Parking in the city also is available for bikers.



TIMELINE

6:00 a.m. Packet Collection opens 6:30 – 7 a.m. 205k Start 8 – 9:30 a.m. 65k Start 9:30 – 11 a.m. 125k Start

9 a.m. – 6 p.m. Finish open



The entire route is marked with fluorescent yellow paint. Arrows show the direction to follow. Exclamation marks (!!!) warn of potentially dangerous points.





PIT STOP - BUFFET

Every 20- 30 km, cyclists' buffets have been prepared. You will find food, drink, sweets and fruit there. There will also be warm meals and soft drinks, as well as toilets. There will be, periodically, live music played.



AID STATIONS

MOTORCYCLE ESCORT

First Aid support and paramedics will be ensuring safety along parts of the course. They will be assisting with traffic measures and available in case help is needed. Dedicated event emergency phone number: +48 514 267 994





POLICE & FIRE BRYGADE

All major junctions will be manned and secured by uniformed members of the emergency services. They will assist in providing a collision-free and enjoyable ride across otherwise difficult parts of the road-based course.



BIKE SERVICE

Mobile bike service mechanics will be patrolling along the route. They will be able to help in case of technical fault. Please remember to have a spare inner tube and pump. The mechanics will not be in a position to sell parts.



SAFETY RULES

The ride takes place on open public roads. The Polish Highway Code applies. Always ride on the righthand side and observes road signs and traffic lights.





AWARDS

Every participant who reaches the finish line receives a medal, a diploma and congratulations. Clubs and teams compete in the CHALLENGE where the winning team has the greatest number of completed kilometers.







FINISH CELEBRATE

The celebration continues at the Finish Line with music, massage, food, drink and health & wellness activity. Purchase a commemorative bike jersey and remember to say "cheese" when posing for the photographers.
